

GCCI's e-Pravesh to institutes

Panaji: The strategic planning and economic development committee of the Goa Chamber of Commerce and Industry (GCCI) will introduce the software e-Pravesh to institutes in the state. The software is an online platform for a complete solution to pre-admission and the prospective student interaction process of any institute. GCCI will facilitate the first presentation on the software for institutes in Goa on Friday.

E-Pravesh follows the Software as a Service (SaaS) or the Pay-per-Use model and hence there is no upfront investment involved in infrastructure or software licenses to be procured by the institutes. This platform can bring students, parents, working executives and educational institutes from kindergarten

to post-graduate level together. GCCI director general, P K Pinto, said, "At present the pre-admission process for autonomous courses is the main target for the usage of this platform. This is an attempt to make use of IT prevalent in educational institutes, to make lives of Indian students better."

E-Pravesh provides solutions and lead to lower budgets for institutions.
